The Promoter had issued the PA seeking to acquire, in accordance with the Delisting Regulations and on the terms and conditions set out therein and in the LOF, up to 24,21,416 Equity Shares representing 33.22% of fully paid-up equity share capital of the Company from the public shareholders of the Company ('Public Shareholders'). Public Shareholders holding Equity Shares were invited to submit bids pursuant to the reverse book-building process ('RBP') conducted through the Stock Exchange Mechanism through NSE during the Bid Period (December 26, 2016

In terms of Regulation 15(1) of the Delisting Regulations, the price determined as Discovered Price (being the price at which the shareholding of the Promoter reaches 90% of the fully paid-up equity share capital of the Company pursuant to the Equity Shares tendered in the RBP) is Rs.204/- (Rupees Two Hundred and Four Only) per Equity Share. The Promoter has accepted the Discovered Price of Rs.204 (Rupees Two Hundred and Four

In terms of Regulation 17(a) of the Delisting Regulations, this Delisting Offer will be deemed to be successful

only if a minimum of 16,92,552 Equity Shares were tendered and acquired in the Delisting Offer at or below the Exit Price so as to cause the cumulative number of Equity Shares held by the Promoter post the acquisition under the Delisting Offer through the Acquisition Window Facility to be equal to or in excess of 65,59,781 Equity Shares

The Promoter will acquire 17,09,671 Equity Shares which were validly tendered at or below the Exit Price, which is higher than the minimum number of Equity Shares (i.e. 16,92,552 Equity Shares) required for the Delisting Offer to be successful in terms of Regulation 17(a) of the Delisting Regulations. After the completion of such acquisition, the shareholding of the Promoter shall be appx. 90.68% of the fully paid-up equity share capital

In terms of Regulation 17(b) of the Delisting Regulations, a minimum of 25% of the Public Shareholders holding Equity Shares in dematerialized form as on July 26, 2016 (i.e. the date of the meeting of the Board of Directors approving the Delisting Offer) were required to participate in the RBP, provided that if the Promoter along with the Manager to the Offer demonstrates that they have delivered the LOF of this Delisting Offer to all the Public Shareholders either through registered post or speed post or courier or hand delivery with proof of dispatch or through email as a text or as an attachment to the email or as a notification providing electronic link or uniform resource locator including a read receipt, then the aforementioned provision of the mandatory participation of at
